SKATE AT YOUR OWN RISK – THIS IS AN UNSUPERVISED FACILITY

While on the skating surface, be alert, flying objects are not uncommon.

Proper protective gear (helmets, knee pads, wrist protectors, proper shoes, etc.) is strongly recommended. The City of Palmer DOES NOT assume responsibility for injury.

Inspect the riding and playing surface before you begin. In the case of an emergency, CALL 911. You are located at 231 E. Arctic Avenue.

Adult supervision is strongly recommended for children under 10 years old.

All surfaces are extremely dangerous when wet or icy. DO NOT use the skateboard park if these unsafe conditions exist.

Know your abilities and skate within them. Exercise common sense and courtesy to others.

No riding when park is closed.

Modifications to the skating surfaces are not allowed. No adding of ramps, jumps or other obstacles.

Use of drugs and alcohol is strictly prohibited. Use of tobacco by minors is prohibited.

No glass containers, food or beverages allowed on the skate surfaces or ramps. Spills jeopardize skater's safety.

Bicycles, motorized skateboards, scooters, cycles or other vehicles not permitted on the skate surface or ramps.

No littering. Please use the trash cans.

Be courteous and respectful of others. Take turns. Have fun.

The Palmer Skateboard Park may be closed until further notice if:

- The skating surface or any part of the facility is damaged.
- Tagging, graffiti or stickers are found on the skate surface or ramps.
- Any liquid other than rain, snow or ice gets on the skating surfaces.
